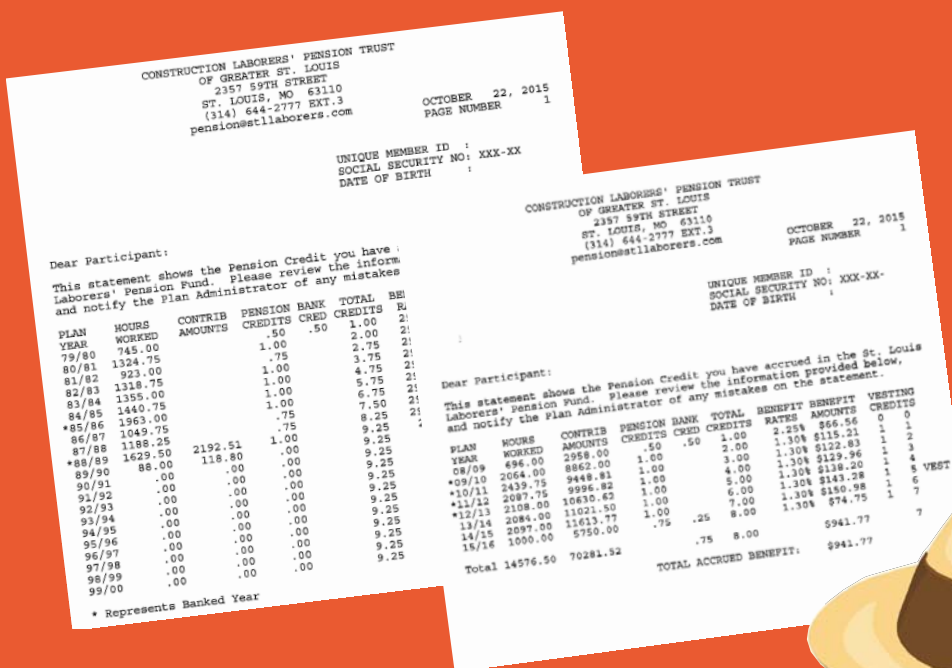


# A conversation with Larry...Pension Summaries!
