For those of you who are new to laboring, under most contracts your employer will withhold a dollar for every hour you work. This amount is what you should expect to see on your vacation check. For Laborers the plan year is October 1st through September 30th and for Mason Tenders it is November 1st through October 31st.

The most important thing to remember when it comes to your vacation check, is to make sure you receive it. What I mean by that is, if the Benefit Office does not have your current address, this could cause a delay in receiving your vacation check. In order to update your address, you will need to complete a Change Request Form. You can find that form at stllaborers.com or call the Benefit Office at 314-644-2777 ext 2.
