The Greater St. Louis Construction Laborers' Welfare Fund (The Fund) is pleased to announce an upcoming change to the administration of your medical benefits.

- Your Medical Network and Managed Care Administrator (Coventry) will transition to its affiliate, **Meritain Health as of October 1, 2017**. Your benefit coverage will not be affected by this change. In regards to your doctors, you should notice very little disruption, if any at all. Meritain Health is not only part of the Coventry Network, but is also part of the Aetna Network, as well. Your coverage options could increase due to access to the dual networks.

With the change to Meritain Health your Tier Network names will change to the following:

Tier 1	Accessing the MO/IL Coventry Network <i>(Previously PPO ASO)</i>
Tier 2	Aetna Choice POS II <i>(Previously Coventry National Network)</i>
Tier 3	Out-of-Network

To check if your doctor is in network, go to www.meritain.com (see the enclosed flyer) or call 866-209-3061.

- In the next couple weeks, you will receive a new insurance card. You will notice a new group number and only one ID number listed for medical, prescription, dental and vision. **Please present your new card at the doctor for any visits beginning October 1, 2017.**
- You will also receive a new **Administrator (Vendor) Insert** with your new insurance card. This Insert should be kept with your Summary Plan Description (SPD). The Insert lists each of our **Benefit Administrators (Vendors)** and their contact information. Our office will send you an updated copy of this Insert if any of the **Vendors** change in the future.

We are working hard to make this change as seamless and uneventful while still providing the best benefits available to you and your family. Watch your mailbox for your new **ID card and Administrator Insert**.
